GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

For general algae and mould control: Clean the surface with an appropriate cleaner. Apply the solution of ALGAEFIX® to the cleaned surface and allow to dry. This will stop spore growth and maintain a clean, presentable surface. A sealer may be applicable in sealing the clean surface. Consult an Adama representative for more information.

For grasses and vegetation: ALGAEFIX® is ideal for golf course and bowling greens, bunkers and sports turf areas.

For Piggeries, Hatcheries and Dairies: Use ALGAEFIX® as a sanitiser after pre-cleaning with a cleaner.

Refer to General use section in DIRECTIONS FOR USE table for application rates.

For establishments requiring the use of the product under the Commonwealth Export Control Act rinse product containing surfaces with potable water after use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in the closed, original container in a cool, dry place out of reach of children. DO NOT store in direct sunlight. Triple or preferably pressure rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsings to the spray tank. DO NOT dispose of undiluted chemicals on site.

If recycling, replace cap and return clean containers to recycler or a designated collection point. If not recycling, break, crush or puncture and deliver empty packaging to an approved waste management facility. If an approved waste management facility is not available bury the empty packaging 500 mm below the surface in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose, clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots, in compliance with relevant Local, State or Territory government regulations.

DO NOT burn empty containers or product.
