Best Use Practices

1. Ensure weeds are actively growing before herbicide application and turf is not mowed 2 days prior or after to ensure best possible results. This allows better absorption.
2. Allow at least 4-10 hours before irrigation or rain to ensure that the spray will be absorbed, the longer the better.
3. Avoid spraying in very hot dry conditions and if frost is likely to occur.
4. Using a suitable surfactant (such as Filmstar) on difficult weeds (must be used on oxalis). This will increase the distribution and adhesion of the spray hence increasing the efficacy.
5. The timing of sprays can be crucial. Weeds are always best sprayed when they are young; at this stage they are most susceptible to herbicides.
6. Spray until weeds and stem are just wet. Spraying beyond this point will encourage run off away from the target area with loss of efficacy.
7. Seeding can take place the day after. However do not apply to newly seeded turf for at least 4 weeks after first mowing (usually 8-12 weeks after germination). Then use the low rate of 30mL/100m².
