



Arrowtown browntop

Key features:

- Exceptionally fine and dense
- Good year-round quality
- Recovers rapidly from renovation
- Medium green foliage colour
- Especially suited to short mown turf such as golf greens

Arrowtown is an elite browntop, being significantly finer and denser than Egmont, Manor and Sefton browntop. Arrowtown recovers rapidly from renovation and is an excellent choice for golf greens. Arrowtown has good year-round quality and is best suited to closer mown, high maintenance situations such as greens, tees and fairways.

Breeding history

Arrowtown was bred by PGG Wrightson Turf from exceptionally fine and dense plants collected from greens at Arrowtown Golf Club by Dr Alan Stewart.

Sowing rate and maintenance

Sow Arrowtown at 5 - 10 g/m² (50 - 100 kg/ha) when sown alone. In mixtures with fine fescues or other cool season species rates of about half of this can be used, however the rates should not be reduced when sowing greens. Arrowtown should emerge in 5 - 10 days after sowing. Full coverage can be expected after 8 weeks. First mowing on greens can take place at 10 mm and be gradually lowered to the desired height.
