Maintenance

These grasses are different and should not be managed as per other bents, but they are tough useful grasses. Summarising this, it means less fertiliser and less water than the old bents that many superintendents are accustomed to and overall the management is easier. The end result is a very high quality playing surface that thrives on low mowing and culminates in a top quality surface, with no extraordinary practices.

Fertiliser formulations and rates may need to be adjusted according to soil test results and turfgrass performance. After the turfgrass has grown in, fertiliser applications should be kept light and infrequent. The first mowing should be done when there is uniform turf coverage with a height from 6 mm and definitely not more than a 12 mm.

Sowing rates

Recommended seeding rate is 5 - 7.5 g/m² (50 - 75 kg/ha) for new plantings, and 0.5 - 1 g/m² (5 - 10 kg/ha) for overseeding.
