



Whittet kikuyu

Key features:

- · Rapid summer growth

Whittet kikuyu is a spring/summer/autumn growing grass suitable for lawns, fairways and sporting fields. Whittet shows rapid summer growth, good drought tolerance, supression of undersirable weeds and is very responsive to nitrogen fertiliser. Implementing good cultural practices such as grooming and the use of growth regulators during the summer months (when not under stress) will create a finer denser playing surface. For unirrigated areas, the minimum average rainfall required is 800 mm in order for Whittet to thrive.

Sowing rate and maintenance

40 - 60 kg/ha.

Whittet can be sown from late spring/early summer through until February.
